

Present Legal Status of Osaka Mosque

Osaka Prefectural Registration office has assigned Osaka Mosque provisional *Shyukyo Hojin* (religious organization) status and the representative and advisory committees are under the rules of the Islamic Cultural Center Osaka (ICCO) *Shyukyo Hojin* Constitution (Provisional).

Income

All donations that are received for the mosque are collected and deposited in the ICCO *Shyukyo Hojin* bank account at least once a month. ICCO *Shadan Hojin* receives income only by charging rent for the mosque property. The monthly income from the donation box is sometimes 40,000 yen or less, so the fixed monthly rent paid into the ICCO *Shadan Hojin* account from ICCO *Shyukyo Hojin* (provisional) as rent for the mosque was fixed at only 40,000 yen. Needless to say ICCO is running at a loss, but at present still has sufficient funds to continue by the grace of Allah.

Donations

Income from donations placed in the collection box every month and deposited in ICCO *Shyukyo Hojin* provisional bank account.

Assets

Presently, the provisional *shyukyo hojin* owns no fixed assets, and is renting the mosque building from the *shadan hojin* which owns the property and pays all the running costs of the mosque. Annual expenses include utilities, taxes and professional fees amount to approximately 60,000 yen per month. When the mosque receives *Shyukyo Hojin* status, all the liquid and fixed assets registered to the present *Shadan Hojin* will be transferred to the religious organization.

Annual General Meeting

An AGM of the representatives and the advisors is held every February to approve a new budget and confirm the representatives and advisors. During our application for Shyukyo Hojin status, we have tried to establish our trustworthiness, stability, and reliability by keeping changes to a minimum.
